This Tools4ISP addon contains some basic configuration settings for our products and handles the Tools4ISP license. Without installing of this addon you will not be able to run Tools4ISP modules.

## 1.2 System requirements

System requirements:

- PHP 7.1+
- PHP mcrypt
- PHP MySQLi
- MySQL (5+)
- Ioncube loader (current version)
- WHMCS installation (> version 6.0 - up to and including version 7.10.2)

This module is fully tested with WHMCS v7.10.2 and PHP v7.8.3 (from Debian, with Zend OPcache). The modules might work with other versions, however we can't really support it in dept and we can't guarantee it.

## 2. Installing the tools4ISP module

If you have already installed the Tools4ISP add-on, **make sure you run the latest version**. If not, update the Tools4ISP add-on to the latest version. If you already run the latest version, you can skip this whole document.

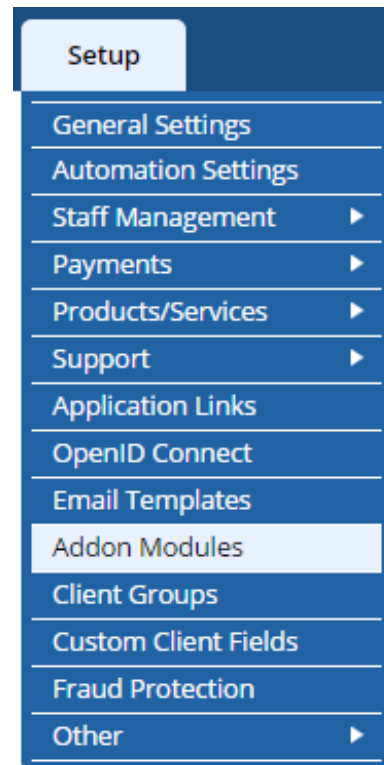
### 2.1 Upload the Tools4ISP module

Download the Tools4ISP module from your client area at <http://my.tools4isp.com>

Extract and Upload the files in your WHMCS installation in:  
<WHMCS root>/modules/addons/tools4isp/  
(overwrite if asked)

### 2.2 Installing the Tools4ISP module

After you've upload the tools4ISP module, login to your WHMCS admin panel. Go to the tab "**Setup**" and select "**Addon Modules**".



Now you'll see a list with installed modules. Find the module **Tools4ISP** and click on the button "Activate". After the module is activated, you'll need to configure the basic settings by selecting the button "Configure".

### 2.3 Configure the Tools4ISP Module

To Configure Tools4ISP for your module, click on the tab "**Addons**" and select "**Tools4ISP**" (if you can't see Tools4ISP, you'll need to refresh the page, otherwise check you've set the right Access Control in the previous step).

Now select the module you want to configure for example: **SIDN**

If you can't see SIDN (or your module RRPproxy, DNSbe, Donuts or Multisite, then upload your module first.

Fill in all the fields that match with your module. In your module documentation you'll find all the details about the required fields.
